


## SELECT Appli-Web Quilting and Craft Ideas TUTORIAL



**1.** Use small pieces of Appli-Web to bond quilt batting to fabric instead of pinning.





**2.** Apply appliqué pieces to base fabrics by drawing or tracing design directly onto Appli-Web.

Using a Teflon or parchment pressing sheet, fuse Appli-Web to the wrong side of decorative fabric.

Use a medium temperature on your iron (no steam) with firm pressure; hold the iron in place for several seconds until bond is achieved.

Once the appliqué has cooled, separate from pressing sheet and cut out the appliqué precisely using the tracing lines.

Fuse to base fabric.



**3.** Applying laces, ribbons to projects.

Cut a piece of Appli-Web slightly larger than lace/ribbon

Press onto back of lace piece using Teflon or parchment sheet, allow to cool and fuse to base fabric.





**4.** Appli-Web has a unique flexible quality and is ideal for delicate or stretch fabrics - great for knit appliqué too!



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
