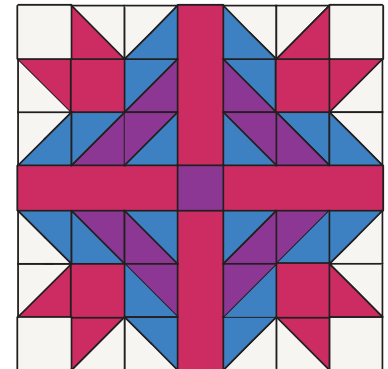
with Quilters Select

Fabric A White
 (1) 2 3/4" strip
 (8) 2 3/4" squares
 (4) 2 1/4" squares

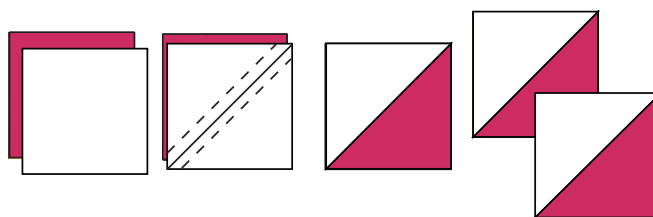
Fabric B Dark Pink
 (1) 2 3/4" strip
 (4) 2 3/4" squares
 (4) 2" x 5 3/4" rectangles
 (4) 2.25" squares

Fabric C Purple
 (1) 2 3/4" strip
 (6) 2 3/4" squares
 (1) 2" square

Fabric D Blue
 (1) 2 3/4" strip
 (10) 2 3/4" squares

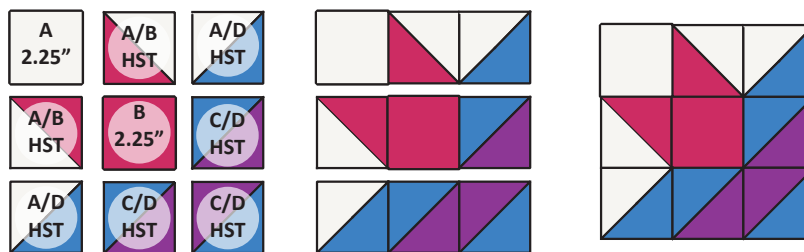


Making the Block:

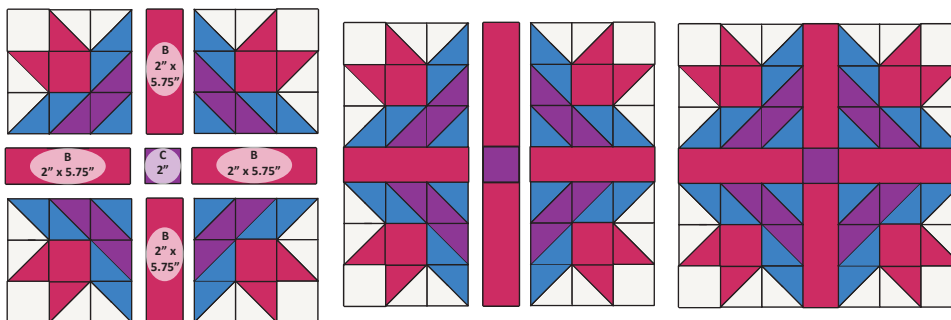


1. Use the diagram above as a guide. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the wrong side of a square. Layer the square right side together with a second square. Sew 1/4" seam on both sides of the diagonal line. Cut along the diagonal line. Press the seams open. You will have 2 HST units. Trim HST units to measure 2 1/4" x 2 1/4". Repeat to make the following HST combinations:

(8) A/B HST (8) A/D HST (12) C/D HST



2. Use the diagram above as a guide. Arrange the Fabric A 2 1/4" squares, Fabric B 2 1/4" squares, A/B HST, A/D HST and C/D HST units as shown. Sew into rows. Sew the rows together to form a corner unit. Repeat to make (4) corner units that measure 5 3/4" x 5 3/4".



3. Use the diagram above as a guide. Arrange the four corner units (Step 2), the four Fabric B 2" x 5 3/4" rectangles and the Fabric C 2" square as shown. Sew into rows. Sew the rows together. Ta-da! You've just stitched Florabesque!
