

Block Skill Level

Confident Beginner Unfinished block: 24.5" x 24.5"

Techniques used: No Waste Flying Geese 4 at a time Half Square Triangles (HST)

Read through all instructions before beginning. WOF=Width of Fabric


Fabric Selection:

- The large center unit is an ideal spot to highlight large print fabric. •
- No Waste and 4 at a Time HST units work well with non-directional prints.
- Block is illustrated as a 2 color variation. Refer to coloring sheets/block variation for 3-color place-• ment.

Recommended Rulers:

- Quilters Select 18" x 18" Non-Slip ruler
- Quilters Select 8 1/2" x12" Non-Slip Ruler

FABRIC	CUT
Fabric A	(1) 9 1/2" square
	(4) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles
	(1) 13 1/2" square
Fabric B	(1) 8 1/2 square (center unit)
	(4) 5" squares
	(1) 13 1/2" square











No Waste Flying Geese:


Fabric A: 9 1/2 square & Fabric B: (4) 5" squares.


- Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Fabric (B).
- Place a Fabric (B) square on opposite corners of Fabric (A), right sides together. Fabric (B) squares will slightly overlap at the center.
- Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line.
- Cut apart on drawn line. Press Fabric (B) away from Fabric (A).
- Place Fabric (B) 5" square on corner of Fabric (A) square, drawn line at the corner. Stitch 1/4" away on each side of the drawn line. Repeat for second unit.
- Cut apart on drawn lines for total of four Flying Geese units.
- Press and trim each unit to 4 1/2" x 8 1/2".












(x4) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2"

Four at a Time Half Square Triangle Units:

Fabric (A): 13 1/2" square & Fabric (B) 13 1/2" square

- Mark diagonal lines in both directions on the wrong side of one of the fabric units.
- Place right sides together; stitch 1/4" along all four outer edges.
- Cut on the marked lines. Press units open and trin each HST to 8 1/2".








Flying Geese Brick Units

Make 4

• Join Flying Geese unit to Fabric (A) : 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle.



Make 4 8 1/2″ x 8 1/2′″

Putting it all Together:

- Stitch together each Row as illustrated.
- Join Rows and press well.
