
DESIGN N STITCH with Quilters Select

Tic Tac Toe

Unfinished block 12.5" x 12.5"



Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"
- Layout block pieces after cutting to keep the units in order for fastest construction.
- Refer to Coloring Sheet and Measurement Notes when laying out the block, prior to stitching.

Featured Technique: Snowball Corners


Recommended Rulers & Notions

- Quilters Select 6 1/2" x12" Non-Slip Ruler
- Quilters Select 3" x 12" Non-Slip Ruler

Fabric 1	(4) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2"
Fabric 2	(8) 2 1/2 " squares (snowball corners/
Fabric 3	(4) 2 1/2" squares
Fabric 4	(2) 3 1/2" x 2 1/2"
Fabric 5	(1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"










Snowball Units (Make 4)

Fabric (1) Four 5 1/2" Squares & Fabric (2): Eight 2 1/2" squares

- Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Fabric (2).
- Align a Fabric (2) square on one corner of Fabric (1),
 right –sides together. Sew along the marked line.
- Align a Fabric (2) square in the corner opposite the first Fabric (2) square, right –sides together. Sew along the marked line.
- Trim 1/4" away from sewn lines (as illustrated by red dotted line).
- Press seams open.
- Repeat for each unit.

Note: if fabrics have directional elements, be sure to position the corner Fabric 2 squares in the correct orientation.






5 1/2" x 5 1/2" Make 4

Vertical Connector Units (Make 2)

Fabric (3) Two 2 1/2" squares & Fabric (4) Two 3 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

- Stitch a Fabric (3) square to a Fabric (4) square on a 2
 1/2" side.
- Press seams toward Fabric (4).
- Repeat with remaining squares.




DESIGN N STITCH with Quilters Select

Horizontal Connector (Make 1)


Fabric (3) 2 1/2" squares & Fabric (5): 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle.


- Stitch a Fabric (3) square to each short end of Fabric (5), right sides together.
- Press seams toward Fabric (3).



Putting it all Together:

- Stitch together each Row as illustrated.
- Join Rows and press well.
