

Technique Featured:

- Strip Set/ 4-Patch Units
 - The technique shown may be used for 4-Patch units with a mix of 2-4 fabrics

Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"



Strip Sets

Set 1:


Fabric (9) Cut (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips Fabric (10) Cut (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips

Set 2:

Fabric (11) Cut (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips Fabric (12) Cut (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips


For <u>directional fabrics</u>: Be sure the fabrics are positioned to keep the fabric pattern going in the same direction.

To keep the fabric positioned with the print upright, be sure to layout & stitch along the



Strip Set A

- Place a Fabric (9) and Fabric (10) strips right sides together.
- Stitch together along length. Press toward Fabric (9). Repeat for remaining Fabric (9) and Fabric (10) strip.








DESIGN N STITCH with Quilters Select

Strip Set B

- Place a Fabric (11) and Fabric (12) strips right sides together.
- Stitch together along length. Press toward Fabric (12). Repeat for remaining Fabric(11) and Fabric (12) strip.




-abric 11 & 12 RST

Total of sixteen 3 1/2: units from Strip Set A & sixteen 3 1/2" units from Strip Set B..

- Cross cut sixteen 3 1/2" units from Strip Set A.
- Cross cut sixteen 3 1/2" units from Strip Set B.

- Stitch units together in pairs to form 4-patch units, nesting the seams to keep centers aligned.
- Press seams to one side or open.
- Make 16 (4-patch units should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2").
