


Join Units


- Layout the units following Unit Layout.

 - Join Row 1 units
 - Join Row 3 units
 - Join rows together

Row 2:

Join the two star legs together as shown.












Stitch newly joined unit to 4-Patch to Flying Goose Unit.





Stitch units together as shown








Join the Rows

- Join as shown.
- Press well.






12 1/2" x 12 1/2 Make 16

Quilt Top Assembly

- To make the final assembly as seamless as possible, give each block a good press. Square up blocks and trim tread ends.
- Join blocks together in quadrants rather than rows to aid in keeping the quilt squared.
- Join quadrants. Press well
- If adding borders to the quilt:
 - Measure the length of the quilt in 3-5 places.
 Take the average of the measurements for the length of the border strips.
 - After attaching the lengthwise strips, measure the width in 3-5 places. Take the average of the measurements for the length of the top/ bottom border strips.
