
- Quarter Square Triangle Units> Ruler Method
 - Method below uses Quilters Select 3N1 Ruler. For Traditional method see Alternate Instructions (last 2 pages), then complete the units following instructions page 3.


Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Cut sizes are listed with length of grain x width of grain, for those working with print fabrics.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"

Quarter Square Units

Background Fabric (C) : Cut (1)	1 1/2 " x 12 "
Fabric 5:	Cut (1)	1 1/2" x 6"
Fabric 6:	Cut (1)	2 1/2" x 6"
Fabric 7:	Cut (1)	1 1/2" x 6"
Fabric 8:	Cut (1)	2 1/2" x 6"






- Straighten one short edge of Fabric 6. Position the Half-Square Triangle side, blunt tip of the 3N1 Ruler along the top edge of the strip, trimmed short edge aligned with straight edge of ruler, bottom of the strip at the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ line. Cut.
- Rotate the ruler 180°, cut. Total: 2 Half Square Triangles (HST).
- Repeat for Fabric 8; cut 2 HST.



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Pro-Tip :

Once triangles are cut, use the blunt tip of the 3N1 ruler to clip the remaining corner of each triangle for more accurate piec-



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- Position the <u>Quarter-Square Triangle</u> end, blunt tip of • the 3N1 Ruler along the top edge of the strip, bottom of the strip at the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ line. Cut the starting angle on the left and the second angle on the right.
- Rotate the ruler 180°, cut. Cut 2 Quarter Square Triangles (QST).
- Repeat for Fabric 7; cut 2 Fabric 7 QST. •
- Repeat for Fabric C; cut 4 Fabric C QST. •


Join the Triangles


- Stitch a QST Fabric 5 to a QST Fabric C. Make 2. •
- Stitch a HST Fabric 6. •
- Make 2. Unit should measure 2 1/2".


- Make 2: Fabrics 5 & C Unit measures 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- Stitch a QST Fabric 7 to a QST Fabric C. Make 2. •
- Stitch to a HST Fabric 8.

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Make 2. Unit should measure 2 1/2".











Make 2: Fabrics 7 & C= Unit measures 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"







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







Complete the Units:

- Cut (2) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Background (C)
- Cut (2) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" Background (C)
- Cut (2) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Background (C)
- Cut (2) 2 1/2"x2 1/2" Background (A)




<u>Top Left Corner</u>

- Join QST unit 7-8 to Background (A) 2 1/2" square.
- Join QST unit 5-6 to Background (C) 2 1/2" square.
- Join the two units together as shown to form partial star.





- Add 4 1/2" 4 1/2" Background (C) to partial star.
- Add 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Background (C) to complete corner.




Bottom Right Corner


Assemble units as for Top Left Corner, taking care to position units as shown.








Partial Star Unit



Assembled Corner 8 1/2″ x 8 1/2″









Quarter Square Units

Background Fabric (C) : Cut (2)	4 "x 4 "
Fabric 5:	Cut (1)	4 "x 4 "
Fabric 6:	Cut (2)	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
Fabric 7:	Cut (1)	4" x 4"
Fabric 8:	Cut (2)	3 1/2"x 3 1/2"




Mark corner to corner on wrong side of Fabric 5 & 7 squares.






- Stitch to each marked square 5 & 7 to a Background (C) • square, right sides together.
- Stitch 1/4" away on each side of the line. •
- Cut along the drawn line, press open.












Make 2: Fabrics 5 & C= HST5

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


- Mark each Fabric 6 from corner to corner.
- Place Fabric 6 square over HST 5, drawn line and seam line in opposite directions.
- Repeat for remaining Fabric C/HST 5.
- Stitch 1/4" away on each side of drawn line.
- Cut along the drawn line, press seam toward Fabric 6.
- Trim units to 2 1/2".

Note: This will result in four units, check the justification of the units for each corner unit as shown. Remaining 2 units are not needed for Barn Star.









Make two justified as shown. Trim to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".

• Repeat for Fabric 8 & HST 7.





Make two justified as shown. Trim to $2 1/2'' \times 2 1/2''$.
