
### Barn Star Stitch Along with Quilters Select

#### *Technique Featured:*

- Flying Geese Units
  - The technique shown below uses a stitch and trim method for more precise units & lends itself well to working with directional fabrics.

#### Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Cut sizes are listed with length of grain x width of grain. For those working with print fabrics.\*
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"



### Flying Geese Units


Background Fabric (C)

Cut (2) 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" geese \*
Cut (2) 9 1/2" x 5 1/2" geese\*\*

Fabrics 1-8:

Cut (1) 5 1/2" square of each (Wings)

- \* For directional fabrics / Goose units with wings 1-2 & 5-6.
- \*\* For directional fabrics/Goose units with wings 3-4 & 7-8.
- <u>Solid or scatter prints:</u> Mark the wrong side of each Fabric (1-8) square, on the diagonal from corner to corner.







Repeat diagonal markings on Wing Squares 1-8.






## ESIGN N STITCH with Quilters Select


- For directional fabrics:
  - Fold Fabric (1) square in half (wrong sides together) to determine which half of the square is justified properly for the unit/unit location.
  - Press the fold.

Note: For better visibility, use a fabric marking pen to draw a line on the wrong side of the fabric, over the fold line.







- Stitch on the marked line.
  - Note: Stitch from the center of the background to the outside corner.
- Cut 1/4" away from stitching line as shown. Press seam toward background.



- Stitch <u>on</u> the marked line.
  - Note: Stitch from the outer corner to the center of the background as shown.
- Trim 1/4" away from stitching line as shown. Press toward b background.
- Trim the unit to 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" taking care to trim the "pointed" side of the unit first ensuring a 1/4" seam allowance is preserved. Goose Unit 1-2complete.
- Repeat for each Goose Unit following color placement diagram (Goose 3-4/ Goose 5-6/Goose 7-8)











Fold WRONG sides of fabric 1 together to audi-



On the wrong side of the fabric, mark the diagonal line on the fold.







Make 1 of each color grouping Total of 4 Goose Units 4 1/2" x 8 1/2"










Cut (2) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" background\*

8 1/2" x 4 1/2" background\*\* Cut (2)




- \*\* For directional fabrics/Goose units with wings 3-4 & 7-8
- Stitch a 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Background (C) to Goose Unit 1-2.
- Press seam allowance toward the background.











Make 1 of each color grouping Total of 4 Goose Units 8 1/2 x 8 1/2"
