
#### Block 3

#### **Techniques Featured:**

- 4 At a Time Half-Square Triangles (HST)
- 3N1 Ruler Half-Square Triangles (optional)

#### Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"



12" x 12" FINSHED


#### Center 4-Patch Unit

Fabric (A)-(D) Cut 1 each 4 1/2" X 4 1/2"

- Stitch Fabric (A) to Fabric (B), right sides together.
- Stitch Fabric (C) to Fabric (D), right sides together.
- Stitch the Unit A/B to C/D as shown.







#### **Corner Units**

Fabric (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Cut (4)

Set aside until HST units are complete.






### Wuilt Along with Quilters Selected


#### Four at a Time HST

Fabric (1): Cut (4) 4 1/2" squares Fabrics (2-5) Cut (1 each fabric) 4 1/2" square


- Place Fabric (1) and Fabric (2) square right sides together.
- Stitch around all 4 edges.
- Cut from corner to corner in both directions.
- Open each resulting HST, press open and trim unit to 2 1/2".
- Repeat for Fabric 3& 1/ Fabric 4 & 1/ Fabric 5 & 1 for a total of four sets of 4 HST units.




Fabric 1 & 2 RST



Stich 1/4" away from edges.





Press and trim to 2 1/2"
(4 HST units)

#### Ruler Method HST

Pro-Tip: The Ruler Method is perfect when working with directional fabrics, small scraps and to minimize fabric waste associated with trimming to size.

Fabric (1): Cut (1) 2 1/2" strip x WOF (note: depending upon the actual WOF a second short strip may be needed)

Fabrics (2-5) Cut (1 from each fabric) 2 1/2" x 15 " strip

- Straighten one short edge of Fabric (1). Position the blunt tip of the 3N1 Ruler along the top edge of the strip, trimmed short fabric edge aligned with the straight edge of the ruler, bottom of the strip at the 2 1/2" line. Cut.
- Rotate the ruler 180°, cut. Continue, cutting 16 triangles.



#### Pro-Tip:

Once triangles are cut, use the blunt tip of the 3N1 ruler to clip the remaining corner of each triangle for more accurate piecing.







## **Suilt Along** with Quilters Selection


#### **Ruler Method HST**

 Repeat the process with Fabric (2-5) strips, cutting 4 triangles from each strip.




#### Pro-Tip:


Once triangles are cut, use the blunt tip of the 3N1 ruler to clip the remaining corner of each triangle for more accurate piecing.



- Position Fabric (1) HST & Fabric (2) HST, right sides together, blunted corners aligned. Stitch. Make 4 Unit A HSTs. Each should measure 2 1/2".
- Repeat for Fabric 3& 1/ Fabric 4 & 1/ Fabric 5 & 1 for a total of four sets of 4 HST units.



Position right sides together and stitch.





Open & press. Units measure 2 1/2". Make 4 each color group.

#### Assemble the Block

Pro-tip: Layout the units as shown to keep all HST correctly oriented prior to stitching.

- Stitch together Row 1 as illustrated.
- Stitch together Row 2 as illustrated
- Stitch together Column 1 and Column 2 as illustrated.
- Stitch Columns 1 & 2 to Center 4-Patch unit.
- Stitch Row 1 & 2 to the top/bottom of the unit.
