### Block 4

#### **Techniques Featured:**

- Flying Geese: Stitch N Flip
- Strip Set 4-Patch

### Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"

### Corner 4-Patch Units


Fabric (1)/Fabric (3) Cut 1 each 2 1/2" X 12" Fabric (2) Cut 2 2 1/2" x 12"

12" x 12" FINSHED



- Place a Fabric (1) and Fabric (2) strip right sides together.
- Stitch together along length. Press toward Fabric (2).





- Straighten one short edge if needed.
- Cut four 2 1/2" units from the strip set.



- Stitch together in pairs to form 4-Patch Units, nesting the seams to keep centers aligned.
- Press seems open; make 4.
- Each 4-Patch should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".









Cross-cut at 2 1/2" for a total of four units 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"









4 units: 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Make 4: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"





### **Wuilt Along** with Quilters Selects

### Flying Geese

Fabric (2):	Cut (4)	5" x 3" (Goose)
Fabric (5)	Cut (4)	5" x 3" (Goose)
Fabrics (4)	Cut (16)	3" x 3" (Wings)


 Mark the wrong side of each Fabric (4) square, on the diagonal from corner to corner.



- 1 2 3 4 5
- Align Fabric (4) square with corner of Fabric (2) rectangle, right sides together, marked line positioned as shown.
- Stitch <u>on</u> the marked line.

Note: Stitch from the center of the background/goose to the corner.


- Trim 1/4" of away from stitching line.
- Press seam open.




Stitch <u>on</u> the marked line.


Note: Stitch from the bottom corner to the center of the unit for more precision.


- Trim 1/4" of away from stitching line.
- Press seam towards the background/goose.
- Make 4. Trim to 4 1/2" x 2 1/2".













Make 4: Trim to 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"

# **QUILTERS SELECT**

### Assemble the Block


- Join pairs of Flying Goose units as shown.
- Make 4: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Fabric (3)

Cut 1

4 1/2" x 4 1/2"


Note: This unit is for the block center and perfect to highlight a fussy cut fabric.






Make 4: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

- Stitch together Units to complete Row 1, Row 2
  & Row 3.
- Join Rows together to complete the block
