Techniques Featured:

- Flying Geese
- Quarter Square Triangle Units

Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"

Flying Geese Units


Note: Pay close attention to the placement of each "wing".

Fabric (1) Fabric (2)	Cut (4)	7" x 4" (Goose)
	Cut (2)	4"x4" (Wings)
Fabric (3)	Cut (2)	4"x4" (Wings)
Fabric (4)	Cut (2)	4"x 4" (Wings)


- Fabric (3)
 Cut (2)

 4"x4" (Wings)
- Mark the wrong side of each 4"x4" wing, on the diagonal from corner to corner.
- Note: Each unit features a different fabric layout, check placement before stitching.
- Align Fabric (2) square with corner of Fabric (1) rectangle, right sides together, marked line positioned as shown. Stitch <u>on</u> the marked line.
- Trim 1/4" away from the stitching line.

Make 1: Trim to 6 1/2" x 3 1/2"

- Bonus Units (optional):
- Stitch a second row 1/2" away
 from the marked line (see illustration) to create Bonus Half-Square
 Units from each "wing" clipping.
 Set these aside for future project.




- Press seam open.
- Align Fabric (3) square with remaining corner of Fabric (1) rectangle.
- Trim 1/4" away from stitching line. Press seam toward goose. Trim unit to 6 1/2" x 3 1/2".



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
• Repeat for each Goose Unit following color placement diagram. (Goose 2-3/Goose 5-2/Goose 4-5/Goose 4-3).



Quarter Square Units

Fabric (2-5) Cut (1 from each) 4 1/2"x 4 1/2" Fabric (2-5) Cut (2 from each) 5"x5"

- Mark corner to corner on wrong side of each 4 1/2" square.
- Mark corner to corner on wrong side of Fabric (3) & (5)
 5" squares.
- Stitch one Fabric (3) 5" square to Fabric (4) 5" square, right sides together & 1/4" away on BOTH sides of the marked line. Cut along the drawn line, press open.
- Stitch Fabric (3) 5" square to Fabric (2) 5" square, right sides together & 1/4" away on BOTH sides of the marked line. Cut along the drawn line, press open.



- Repeat with Fabric (5) & (2) and with a Fabric (5) & (4) using the remaining 5" squares.
- Only one of each HST unit is needed for the block, set the Bonus HST aside for another project.

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Quarter Square Units cont.

- Place Fabric (2) square over HST 3-4, drawn line and seam line running in opposite directions.
- Stitch 1/4" away on each side of drawn line.
- Cut along drawn line.
- Press & trim (to 3 1/2" square) the unit with the color orientation as shown. Set the remaining Bonus Unit.







Trim to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

- Place Fabric (5) square over HST 2-3, drawn line and seam line running in opposite directions.
- Stitch 1/4" away on each side of drawn line.
- Cut along drawn line.
- Press & trim (to 3 1/2" square) the unit with the color orientation as shown. Set the remaining Bonus Unit.








Trim to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

- Place Fabric (4) square over HST 2-5, drawn line and seam line running in opposite directions.
- Stitch 1/4" away on each side of drawn line.
- · Cut along drawn line.
- Press & trim (to 3 1/2" square) the unit with the color orientation as shown. Set the remaining Bonus Unit.





Trim to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

- Place Fabric (3) square over HST 4-5, drawn line and seam line running in opposite directions.
- Stitch 1/4" away on each side of drawn line.
- Cut along drawn line.
- Press & trim (to 3 1/2" square) the unit with the color orientation as shown. Set the remaining Bonus Unit.







Trim to 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"






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Quarter Square Units Ruler Method

Fabric (2-5) Cut (1 from each) 3 1/2" x 4" strip


- Straighten one short edge of Fabric 2 strip. Position the Half Square Triangle side, blunt tip of the 3N1 Ruler along the top edge of the strip, bottom of the strip at the 3 1/2" line. Cut.
- Repeat for Fabrics 3-5.




- Position the Quarter Square Triangle end, blunt tip of the ruler along the top edge of the strip, bottom edge of strip at the 2" line.
- Cut the starting angle on the left and second angle on the right.
- Rotate the rule 180°, cut. Cut 2 QST from each strip.

Join the QST Units:

- Follow color diagram for placement:
 - Stitch QST Fabric 4 to QST 3. Press seam open.
 - Stitch HST 2 to the 3-4 HST.
 - Stitch QST Fabric 2 to QST 3. Press seam open.
 - Stitch HST 5 to 2-3 HST.
 - Stitch QST Fabric 5 to QST 2. Press seam open.
 - Stitch HST 4 to 5-2 HST.
 - Stitch QST Fabric 4 to QST 5. Press seam open.
 - Stitch HST 3 to 4-5 HST.
- Each unit should measure 3 1/2"



















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Assembling the Block

Cut 4 Fabric (1):

3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares

Pro-tip: Layout the units as shown to keep all HST correctly oriented for stitching.



Stitch together center QST units as shown.










6 1/2" x 6 1/2"

- Join the units to form Rows 1-3 as illustrated.
- Join the Row together and press. Block should measure 12 1/2" square for a 12" finish.







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
