Block 7 Techniques Featured:

- Flying Geese: Stitch N Flip
- 8-at-Time HST
- Square in a Square: Stitch N Flip

Pro-Tips:

- *Read through all instructions before beginning.*
- *Seam Allowance= 1/4"*

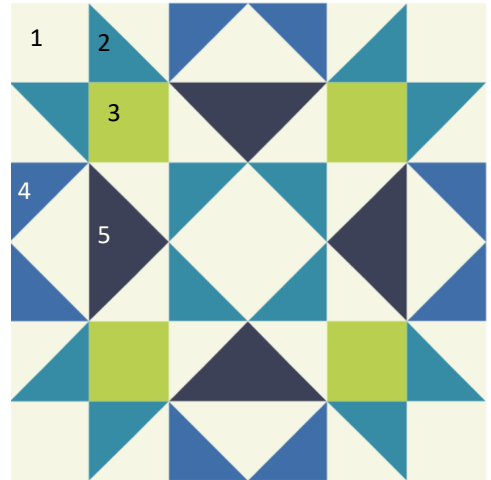
Corner Units

8 at a time HST

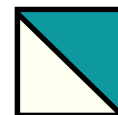
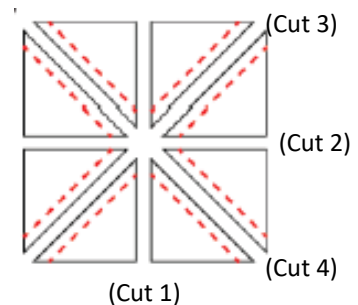
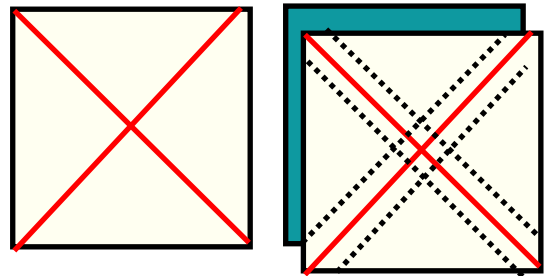
Fabric (1)/Fabric (3) Cut 4 each 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

Fabric (1)/Fabric (2) Cut 1 each 6" x 6"

- Mark diagonal lines in both directions on wrong side of Fabric (1) 6" square.
- Place Fabric (2) & Fabric (1) 6" squares, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" away on each side of both marked lines.
- Cut the unit in half vertically, then horizontally and again on each drawn line.
- Press each HST unit open, trim to 2 1/2".

Trim to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



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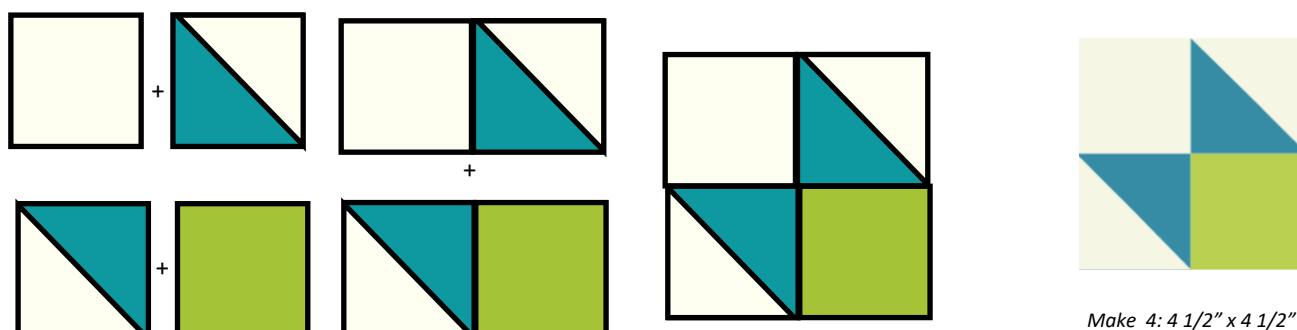
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Corner Units

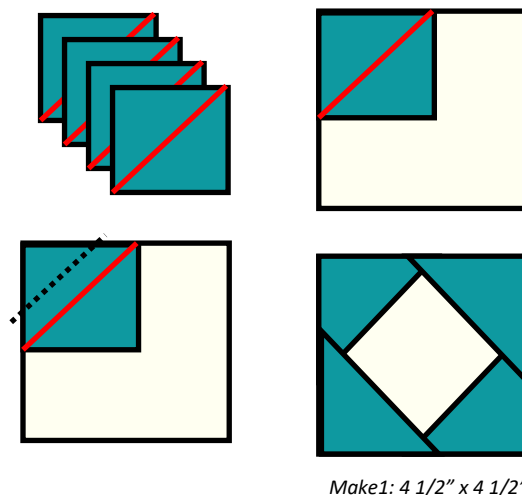
- Stitch together Fabric (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square & HST as shown.
- Stitch together HST & Fabric (3) as shown.
- Stitch the units together to make a 4 patch corner unit.
- Make 4.



Center Square in Square

Fabric (1)	Cut 1	$4\frac{1}{2}$ x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
Fabric (2)	Cut 4	$2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

- Mark a line corner to corner on the wrong side of each Fabric (2) square.
- Align a marked square in the corner of Fabric (1); unmarked corner should be in the corner of Fabric (1).
- Stitch *on* the line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the stitched line toward the corner of the square.
- Press Fabric (2) open. Repeat for each corner of Fabric (1).
- Finished unit: $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".

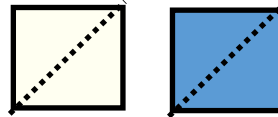


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Flying Geese

Fabric (1):	Cut 4	5" x 3" (Goose)
Fabric (4)	Cut 8	3" x 3" (Wings)
Fabric (5)	Cut 4	5" x 3" (Goose)
Fabric (1)	Cut 8	3" x 3" (Wings)

- Mark the wrong side of each 3" x 3" square, on the diagonal from corner to corner.

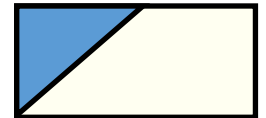
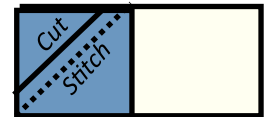


Fabric (1) & Fabric (4) Units

- Align Fabric (4) square with corner of Fabric (1) rectangle, right sides together, marked line positioned as shown.
- Stitch on the marked line.

Note: Stitch from the center of the background/goose to the corner.

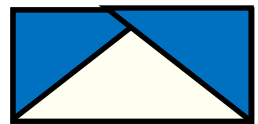
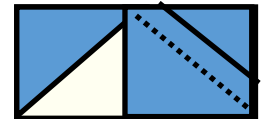
- Trim 1/4" of away from stitching line, towards the outer corner.
- Press seam open.



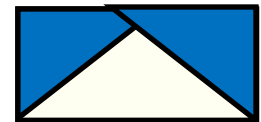
- Align Fabric (4) square with other corner of Fabric (1) rectangle, right sides together, marked line positioned as shown.
- Stitch on the marked line.

Note: Stitch from the bottom corner to the center of the unit for more precision.

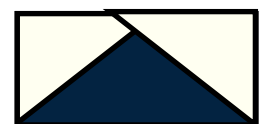
- Trim 1/4" of away from stitching line, toward outer corner.
- Press seam towards the background/goose.
- Make 4. Trim to 4 1/2" x 2 1/2".



Make 4: Trim to 4 1/2" x 2 1/2"



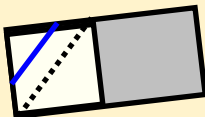

Bonus Units (optional):

Stitch a second row 1/2" away from the marked line (see illustration) to create Bonus Half-Square Units from each "wing" clipping. Set these aside for future project.

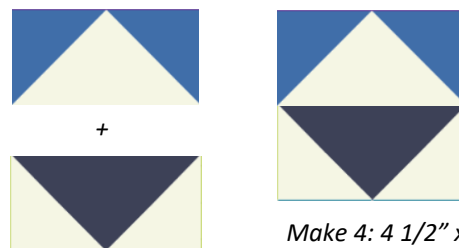


- Repeat with Fabric (5) and (1).
- Make 4. Trim to 4 1/2" x 2 1/2".

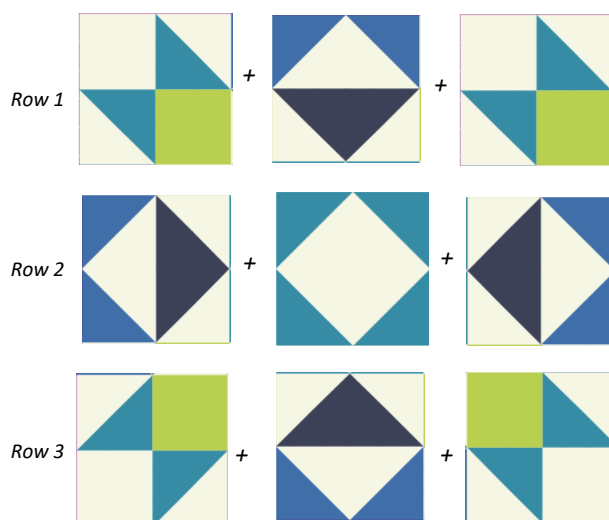
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Assemble the Block

- Join pairs of Flying Goose units as shown.
- Make 4: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"



- Stitch together Units to complete Row 1, Row 2 & Row 3.
- Join Rows together to complete the block

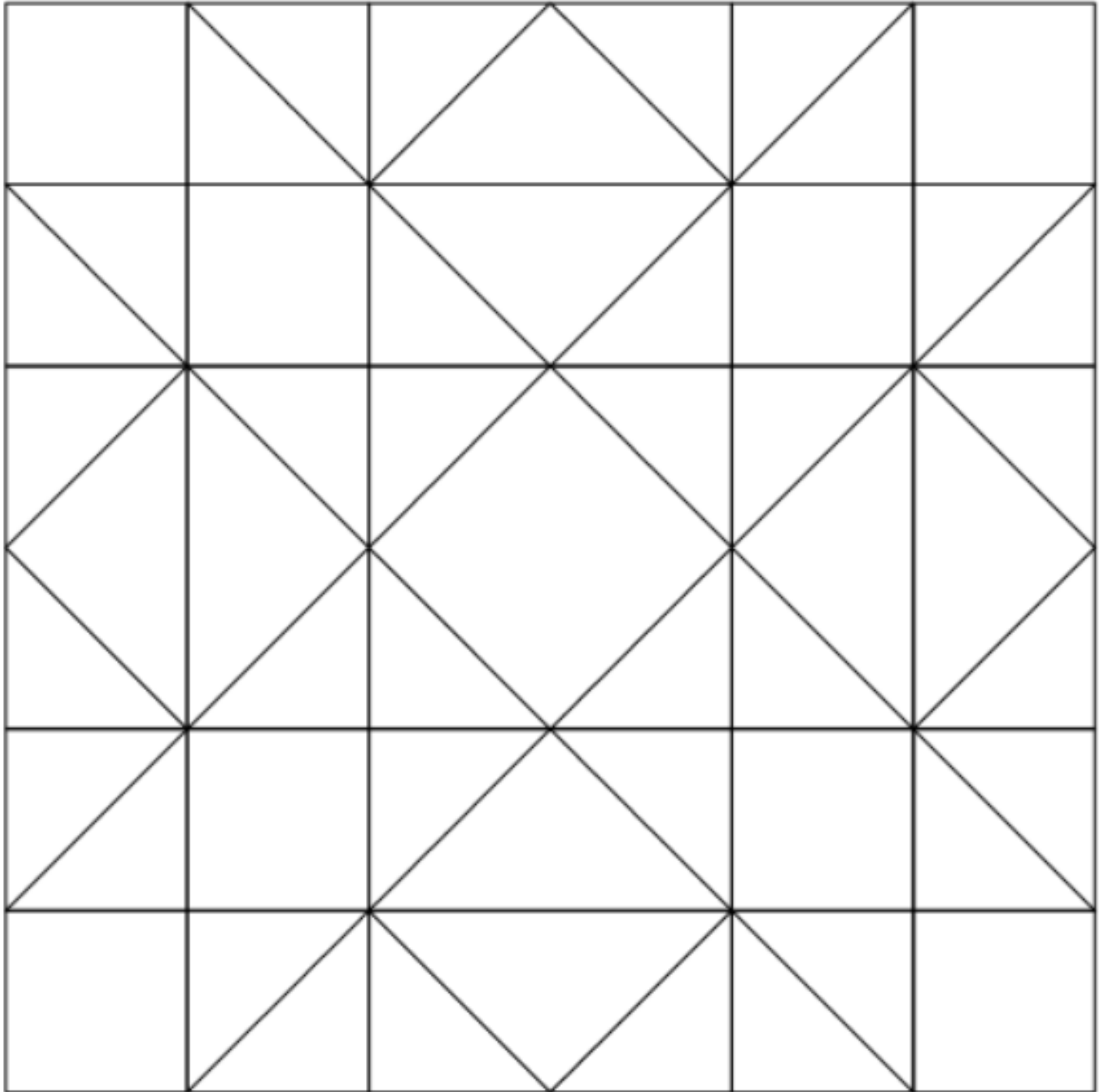


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
