

<u>Corner Units</u>

Fabric (1)

Cut 4

2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



12" x 12" FINSHED

8 at a time HST Fabric (1)/Fabric (2)

Cut 1 each 6" x 6"


- Mark diagonal lines in both directions on wrong side of Fabric (2) 6" square.
- Place Fabric (2) & Fabric (1) 6" squares, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" away on each side of both marked lines.
- Cut the unit in half vertically, then horizontally and again on each drawn line.


• Press each HST unit open, trim to 2 1/2".



Design

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Flying Geese

Fabric (3):	Cut 4	5″ x 3″ (Goose)
Fabric (2)	Cut 8	3" x 3" (Wings)

- Mark the wrong side of each 3" x 3" square, on the diagonal from corner to corner.
- Align Fabric (2) square with corner of Fabric (3) rectangle, right sides together, marked line positioned as shown.
- Stitch <u>on</u> the marked line.


Note: Stitch from the center of the background/goose to the corner.

- Trim 1/4" of away from stitching line, to remove the outer corner.
- Press seam open.
- Align Fabric (2) square with other corner of Fabric (3) rectangle, right sides together, marked line positioned as shown.
- Stitch <u>on</u> the marked line. Note: Stitch from the bottom corner to the center of the unit for more precision.
- Trim 1/4" of away from stitching line, to remove the outer corner.
- Press seam towards the background/goose.
- Make 4. Trim to 4 1/2" x 2 1/2".


Bonus Units (optional):


Stitch a second row 1/2" away from the marked line (see illustration) to create Bonus Half-Square Units from each "wing" clipping. Set these aside for future project.



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Center Square in a Square Squared

Fabric (1):	Cut 1	6″x 6″
Fabric (5):	Cut 4	3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
Fabric (4):	Cut 2	5 1/2" x 5 1/2"

- Mark each Fabric (5) corner to corner.
- Position Fabric (5) in the corner of Fabric (1), right sides together. Stitch one the market line. Repeat for opposite corner. Trim away 1/2" from stitching line.
- Repeat for remaining corners.
- Stitch remaining Fabric (5) triangles to each side of Fabric (1).






Cut as indicated by dotted lines.





6″x6″

- Cross cut each Fabric (4) square in half once on the diagonal.
 - Stitch a Fabric (4) triangle to two opposing sides of center unit.
 - Stitch remaining triangles the remaining sides of center unit.
 - Square center to 8 1/2" x 8 1/2".








Assemble the Block


- Join HST and Goose Units as shown.
- Make two. Each strip measures 2 1/2" x 8 1/2"



- Stitch together Units to complete Row 1, Row 2 & Row 3
- Join Rows together to complete the block.



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
