Block 9 Techniques Featured:

- 8-at-Time HST (Half Square Triangle)
- Quarter Square Triangle Units

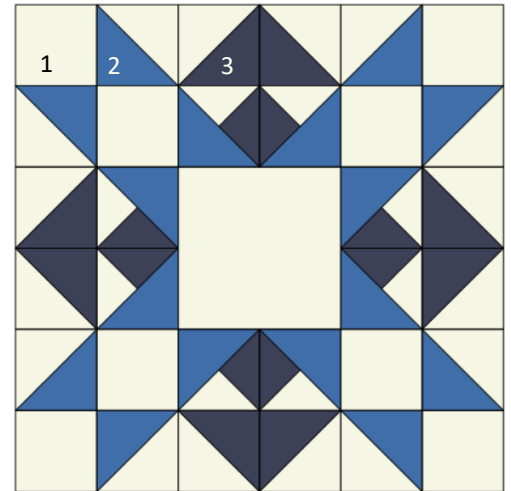
Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"

Corner Units

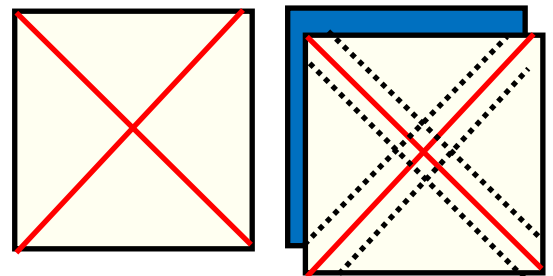
Fabric (1) Cut 8 each 2 1/2" X 2 1/2"

Fabric (1) & Fabric (2) Cut 1 each 6" x 6"

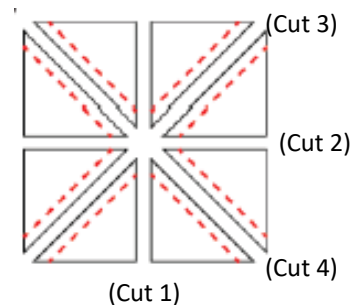


12" x 12" FINISHED

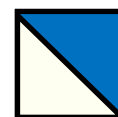
- Mark diagonal lines in both directions on wrong side of Fabric (1) 6" square.
- Place Fabric (2) & Fabric (1) 6" squares, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" away on each side of both marked lines.



- Cut the unit in half vertically, then horizontally and again on each drawn line.



- Press each HST unit open, trim to 2 1/2".



Make 8:
Trim to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



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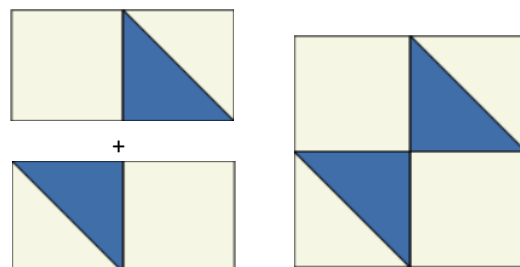
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Corner Units

- Stitch together Fabric (1) 2 1/2" square & HST as shown.
- Make 8 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2")
- Stitch units together as shown to create 4-patch corner units.
- Make 4 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2")



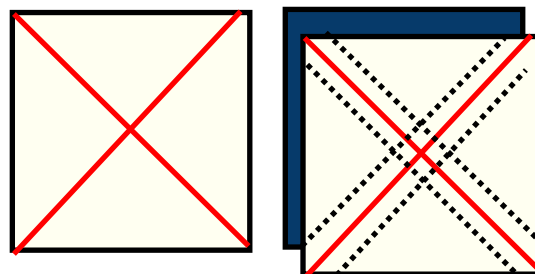
Make 4: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Faux Geese

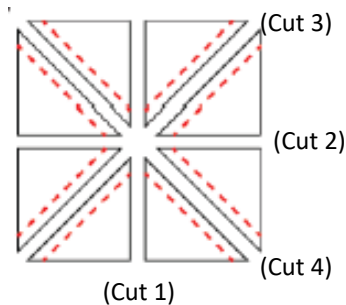
These little units are stitched from HSTs for more options when recoloring but experienced stitchers may wish to substitute Flying Geese. Each Flying Goose should measure 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" trimmed (4"x2" finished).

8 at a Time HST

Fabric (1)	Cut 1	6" x 6"
Fabric (3)	Cut 1	6" x 6"



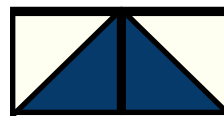
- Mark diagonal lines in both directions on wrong side of Fabric (1) 6" square.
- Place Fabric (1) & Fabric (3) 6" squares, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" away on each side of both marked lines.
- Cut the unit in half vertically, then horizontally and again on each drawn line.



- Press each HST unit open, trim to 2 1/2".
- Stitch in pairs to make four "Faux Goose" units. Each unit measures 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"



Make 8:
Trim to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Make 4: 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"



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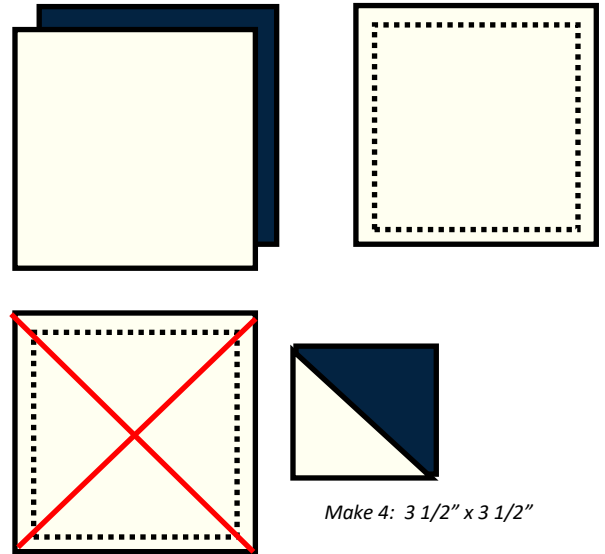
Quarter Square Triangle Units

Step 1:

Fabric (1): Cut 1 5.5" x 5.5"

Fabric (3) Cut 1 5.5" x 5.5"

- Place Fabric (1) & (3) right sides together; stitch around all four edges.
- Cut corner to corner in both directions. Press and trim to 3 1/2" squares.



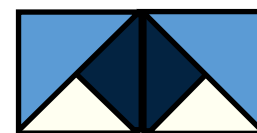
Step 2

Fabric (2) Cut 4 3.5" x 3.5"

- Mark each Fabric (2) from corner to corner.
- Place Fabric (2) over HST, drawn line and HST seam line in opposite directions.
- Stitch 1/4" away on each side of the drawn line.
- Cut along the drawn line, press and trim each unit to 2 1/2".
- Repeat for each Fabric (2), HST for a total of eight Quarter Square units. Note there are four mirror image pairs.
- Join pairs to create four units as shown. Each measures 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"



Make 4 each : 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Make 4 : 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

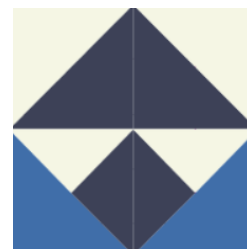
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Assemble the Block

- Fabric (1) Cut 1 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- Join Quarter Square Units and Faux Goose units.
- Make 4.



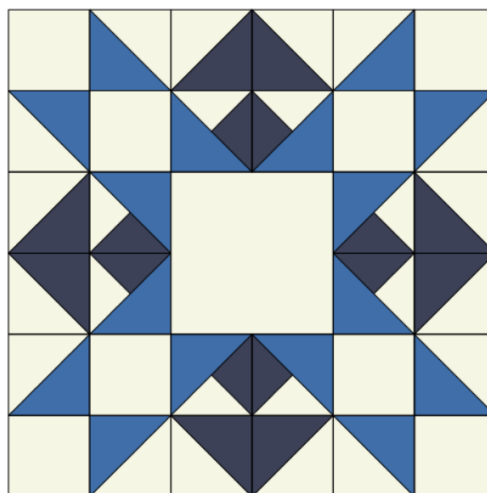
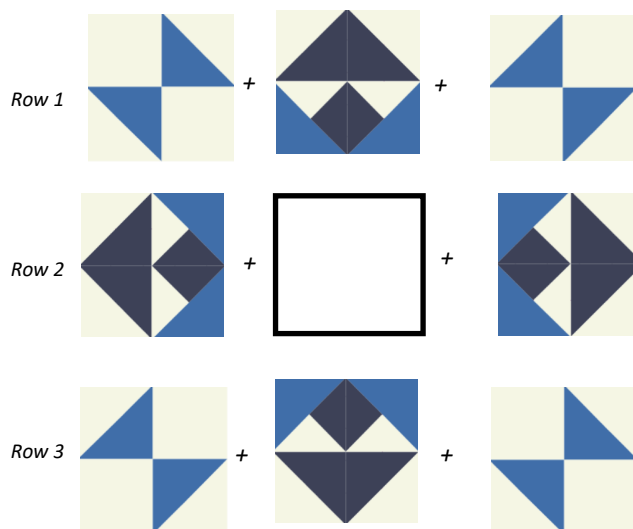
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Make 4: 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

*Layout each unit; double check justification/
direction of the unit.*

- Stitch together Units to complete Row 1, Row 2 & Row 3.
- Join Rows together to complete the block

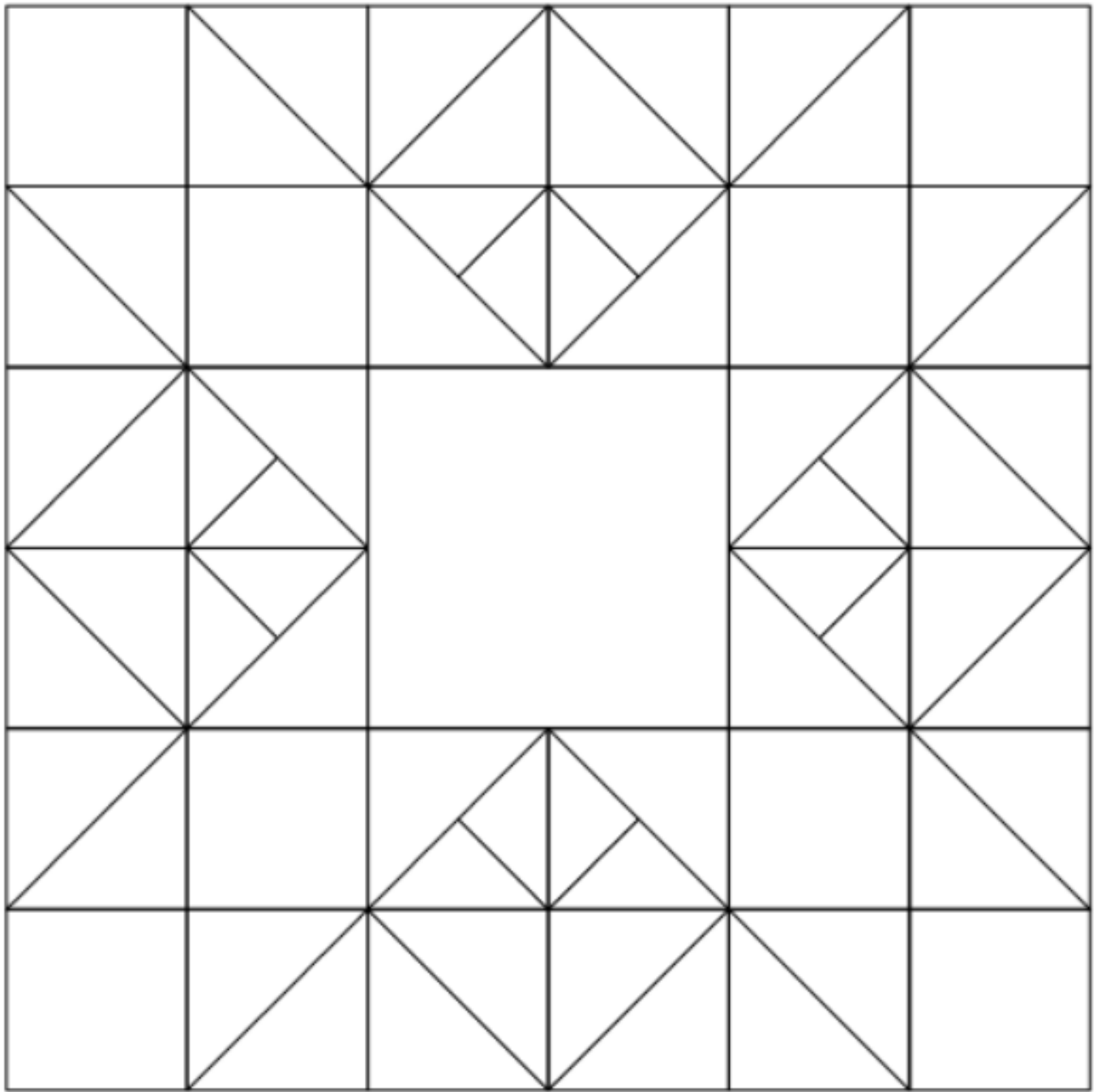


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
