

# Sun Patch Placemats



## Cutting Instructions - for 2 placemats - 12" x 16" each

### Fabric A - background - 1/2 yard, cut:

4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF - sub cut into: 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 12 1/2"  
 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"  
 18 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

2 strips 1 1/2" x WOF - sub cut into: 2 rectangles 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"  
 4 rectangles 1 1/2" x 10 1/2"

### Fabric B - binding and accent strip - 3/8 yard, cut:

1 strip 1 1/2" x WOF - sub cut into: 2 rectangles 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"

4 strips 2 1/4" x WOF - piece together across short ends for double fold binding

### Color Fabric Squares

20 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

### Backing - 3/4 yard, cut:

2 rectangles 20" x 24" (oversized in case they are being quilted on a long arm)




## Block Instructions

Follow arrows for pressing suggestions.

1. Refer to the block assembly diagram and using 10 color fabric squares, 9 squares of fabric A and 2 fabric A 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles make a block. The block should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2".
2. Repeat step 1 to make the second block with the other 10 color fabric squares.
3. Refer to the placemat assembly diagram and sew a fabric A 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom of the blocks. Press to fabric A.
4. Sew a fabric A 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle to the right side of the block. Press to fabric A.
5. Sew a fabric A 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle to the left side of the block. Press to fabric A.
6. Sew a fabric B 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle to the left side of the block. Press to fabric B.
7. Sew a fabric A 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle to the left side of the block. Press to fabric B. The placemat top should measure 12 1/2" x 16 1/2". Make 2 placemats.
8. Layer the placemat top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Use the binding strip to bind the placemats.
