

Be Still: O-Block Construction

Pro-Tips:

- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"
- O Block construction is the same for each variation shown in the Just the Facts handout; the number of O units needed may differ. Refer to your planned layout/coloring sheet for the number of X units required.
- For the Be Still Layout shown, fifteen O Blocks will be stitched. Each O Block will measure 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" for a finished 9" block.




Be Still Layout

54 1/2" x 63 1/2" before borders

Assembling the O Blocks:

- Gather four Signature Units; place wrong side up. Position so that the adjoining seams will nest together during construction.
- Stitch the top 2 units together.
- Stitch the bottom 2 units together.
- Stitch Unit A to Unit B.



O unit should measure
9 1/2" x 9 1/2"

- Press center VERTICAL seam allowances in opposite directions, consistent with X block vertical seam direction.
- Press center HORIZONTAL seam allowance toward the TOP edge of the block.
- Press each block in the same manner for ease in joining the rows.

- Signature units with directional base fabrics will be assembled in the same manner, nesting the side pressed seams with the open seams (mini-nest/refer to video for more details).
