

## Skill Builder: 4 at a Time Half Square Triangles (HST)

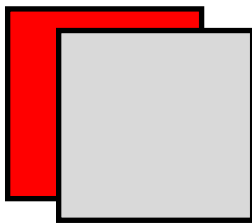
- Speed Piecing >4 at a time Half Square Units
- Cutting chart included

### Pro-Tips:

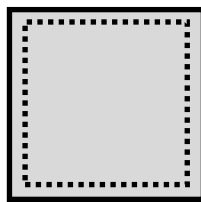
- 4 at a Time HST technique is best used for solids or scatter prints.
- Note that this method results in the bias edges being placed on the outside edge of the units. Take care not to stretch.
- Read through all instructions before beginning.
- Seam Allowance= 1/4"

### Four at a Time HST

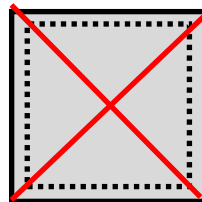
- Determine the size HST needed and refer to the 4 At a Time Chart for cutting information.
- Place Fabric (A) & Fabric (B) squares right sides together.
- Stitch around all 4 edges.
- Cut units from corner to corner in both directions.
- Open each resulting half-square unit. Press seam allowance open; trim unit to size.
- Repeat to create number of HST needed.



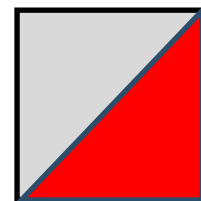
Fabric A+B RST



Stich 1/4" away from out side edges.



Cut from corner to corner in both directions.



Press and trim to size.

Makes 4.....



# Quilt Along with QUILTERS SELECT.

Four at a Time Half Square Triangle Units :

Starting Square =  
 (Desired Finished Size + .5")/.64  
 Round up .5-1"
